HORSE SECTION – Regulations

INDEMNITY AND WAIVER FORMS: Competitors taking part in this Horse Section do so at their own risk. Each competitor must complete and sign a form indemnifying the Baradine PA&H Association and waiving any claims against the Association for any injury sustained in competition or for loss or damage to the competitor's property or damage caused by the competitor or his/her animal(s) at the Show.

Rider Wristbands: Upon signing of waiver form riders will be provided with a wrist band that MUST be worn at all times.

Refusal of Nomination/Alteration of Schedule: The committee reserves the right to refuse an entry without assigning any reason for doing so and to alter the schedule without notice.

Entering/Leaving the Ring: All competitors shall enter and leave the Ring in a dignified manner. Any person using offensive language to Judges or Stewards, or any other person, may be disqualified by the Committee for such a period of times as the Committee deems fit. No person will be allowed in the ring, with the exception of Judges and Stewards while a competition is in progress.

Lateness to the Ring: Competitors must be ready when called. Once judging has commenced, a competing horse shall enter the judging ring without the permission of the judge and/or the Ringmaster.

Judge's Decision/Discretion: The judge's decision will be final.

Local Classes: An exhibitor whose permanent residence is located within 75 kilometre of the Baradine Showground and is the legal owner or lease of the exhibit for no less than three months.

Maiden Hack: A Maiden has not received a place in any individual hack at any Show.

Novice Hack: A Novice has not won a First Place at any Show.

Intermediate Hack: A horse which has not placed First, Second or Third at any royal show or HOTY.

Hunters: Horses can enter as either a Hunter or a Hack, NOT BOTH.

Stallions: Stallions must be wearing a bit at all times when being led and must be under the control of a person 17 years of age or older. They must be supervised at all times and securely fastened when tied to the outside of a truck or float. They are not eligible to compete in ridden classes unless stated in the schedule. Stallions shall not participate in any classes other than Breed classes and must be shown with a bit.

Ponies with Adult Riders: Ponies may be ridden by adults unless otherwise stated in the schedule.

Use of Rings: Rings are not allowed in Hack classes.

Blind horses: Horses blind in an eye may only compete in Led classes.

Trophies: All perpetual horse trophies shall be retained by the association and engraved with the winners name.

Helmets: Every rider is encouraged to wear a safety helmet compliant with the current Australian Standard. Riders under 18 years must wear such a helmet.

Footwear: All competitors must wear appropriate footwear when leading or riding a horse.

Cruelty: Persons who are considered by the Ringmaster or Steward to be abusive or cruel to a horse will be expelled from the ground. No horse will be permitted to compete if, in the opinion of the Ringmaster or Steward, it is in poor health or condition.

Drugs: Drug testing may be carried out at this show. Any owner and/or exhibitor who presents a horse which tests positive to a prohibited substance will be subject to investigation by the ASC Disciplinary Committee. Any penalty imposed as a result of an infringement will be fully supported by this society.

Proper Conduct: Any exhibitor or associate who behaves offensively on the Showground will be expelled from the ground, may be banned from the show in future and may be banned by other Societies.

Protests: A protest or complaint against any exhibit or exhibitor may be lodged verbally with the Ringmaster or Steward no later than ten minutes after the judging of the exhibit or exhibitor. A protest or complaint or an appeal against the decision of the Ringmaster or Steward may be lodged in writing with the Secretary on the day of judging. Such protest, complaint or appeal shall be accompanied by a deposit of \$50 which shall be forfeited if the protest, complaint or appeal proves to be frivolous or vexatious.

Registration/Membership: All horses and ponies must be registered with relevant Breed or Colour Society and papers to be produced on request. Competitors must be current financial members of the relevant Breed or Colour society and proof of membership to be produced on request.

Section A - Supplier's statements about risk and duty of care

2. I participate in the Event and/or use of the Suppliers' facilities at my own risk.

9. In handling animals, there is a risk of suffering injury including injuries caused by the animals.
10. I am responsible for ensuring that I have and will wear equipment suitable for my safety in my participation of the Event and/or in using the Suppliers' facilities.
11. I am responsible for the condition of any tools and equipment and ensuring that they are appropriate for the Event and/or in using the Suppliers' facilities.

12. I use the Suppliers' facilities, including for the Event entirely at my own risk, as I find them and with the prior acceptance of the risk of possible danger to me, both obvious and inherent.
13. At the time of participating in the Event and/or in using the Suppliers' facilities, I will not to any degree be under the influence of alcohol or illicit drugs.
14.
