Checklist Horse exhibitors are responsible for erecting their own yards after gaining precise information on the location and dimensions of the space allocated for each yard. While it is easy for those accustomed to working with electric fences to shrug off the occasional zap, it only takes a moment's reflection to realise that an installation capable of jolting a horse into staying clear is a risk to the old, the very young and the infirm in a public space. When constructing each yard, please ensure all of the following requirements are met.
