Note: This class open only to numbered horses entered in or accepted for entry in the Stud Book of the Commonwealth Clydesdale Horse Society (Registrar, Royal Showgrounds, Epsom Rd. Ascot Vale, Vic 3032).

Two-year-olds and yearlings will be allowed to compete, providing their sires and dams are registered with the above Society. In the case of fillies eligible for registration, but whose dams are not eligible, such fillies must be registered or accepted for registration by the above Society and date of Show, unless otherwise expressed. All stallions, 2 years and over, must be provided with bar and chain; other exhibits to be halter-led into the judging ring.

Exhibitors throughout this Class must supply name, colour, age, sex and pedigree with entry. Age of all horses shall date from August 1.

LOOSE BOXES

The Society has 6 Lockup Loose Boxes on the Showground, the charges for which have been fixed at \$2.00 each. Boxes will be allotted at time of entry, but not before the charge for the box has been paid. Stallions will have the preference of all boxes.

All exhibits in this Class must be ready for judging at 10.30am.

NOTE: A three year old filly in foal or with a foal at foot is not regarded as a brood mare until it attains the age of four years calculated on the breeding year.
