Frequently Asked Questions

> What will be sold at the BBQ?

Sausage on a roll (with the option of onions and sauces) and a bottle of water - sausages and onions are the only items that will be cooked.

What's required of us?

- Bring approximately **8 volunteers** to participate. (Many hands make light work)
- Complete all necessary inductions
- Attend morning brief before your day on the BBQ
- Bring your hardworking attitude and smile
- Spread the word about the local show to the crowds
- Will you have to have had training in food safety?

The RAS will hire a supervisor for the area that will be present every day of the show.

> Do you have accommodation? If so, when can you access it?

We have limited accommodation onsite that will be provided free of charge. This will be for the night before your allocated day and will be available from 6pm.

> Do we need to bring anything for the BBQ?

No - All food, cooking equipment, gloves, aprons will be provided. As noted, if you are to use the accommodation, please bring appropriate linen/sleeping bag/swag.

How much money do you take home? What's the cost to you?

Show Societies will need to arrange their own travel and any additional accommodation, otherwise there is no cost. All profits made on the day you host the BBQ go straight back to your Show Society. We will collect the cash each day and send you out a cheque for the amount you have raised.

How do we get access to the site?

Once the Show Societies have been selected and allocated days we will provide you with entry tickets for all of your volunteers on the BBQ. We will also provide a limited number of parking tickets at P5 if required for your group

> If our Show Society has participated before can we apply again?

Even if you have participated in the Big Bush BBQ before, you are more than welcome to submit an application form for next year. However, please note that due to limited spaces, preference will be given to Show Societies who have not participated previously.
