## PESTIVIRUS (BOVINE VIRAL DIARRHOEA VIRUS)

## Suggested Wording for Show Schedules

- Cattle must not be exhibited unless tested for Pestivirus and certified as non Persistently Infected (PI) cattle.
- Certification of testing and proof of non PI status will be required at the time of Entry in the form of a signed Veterinary Certificate or Laboratory Report, listing animals and their identification. Testing results will be verified by the Cattle Section.
- A National Cattle Health Declaration must be completed for all cattle attending your show. A copy of the declaration is available on the website and also attached here: <u>https://www.farmbiosecurity.com.au/wp-content/uploads/2022/11/National-Cattle-</u> <u>Health-Declaration\_2022.pdf</u>. This form also confirms, among other things, Pesti Virus Vaccination.
