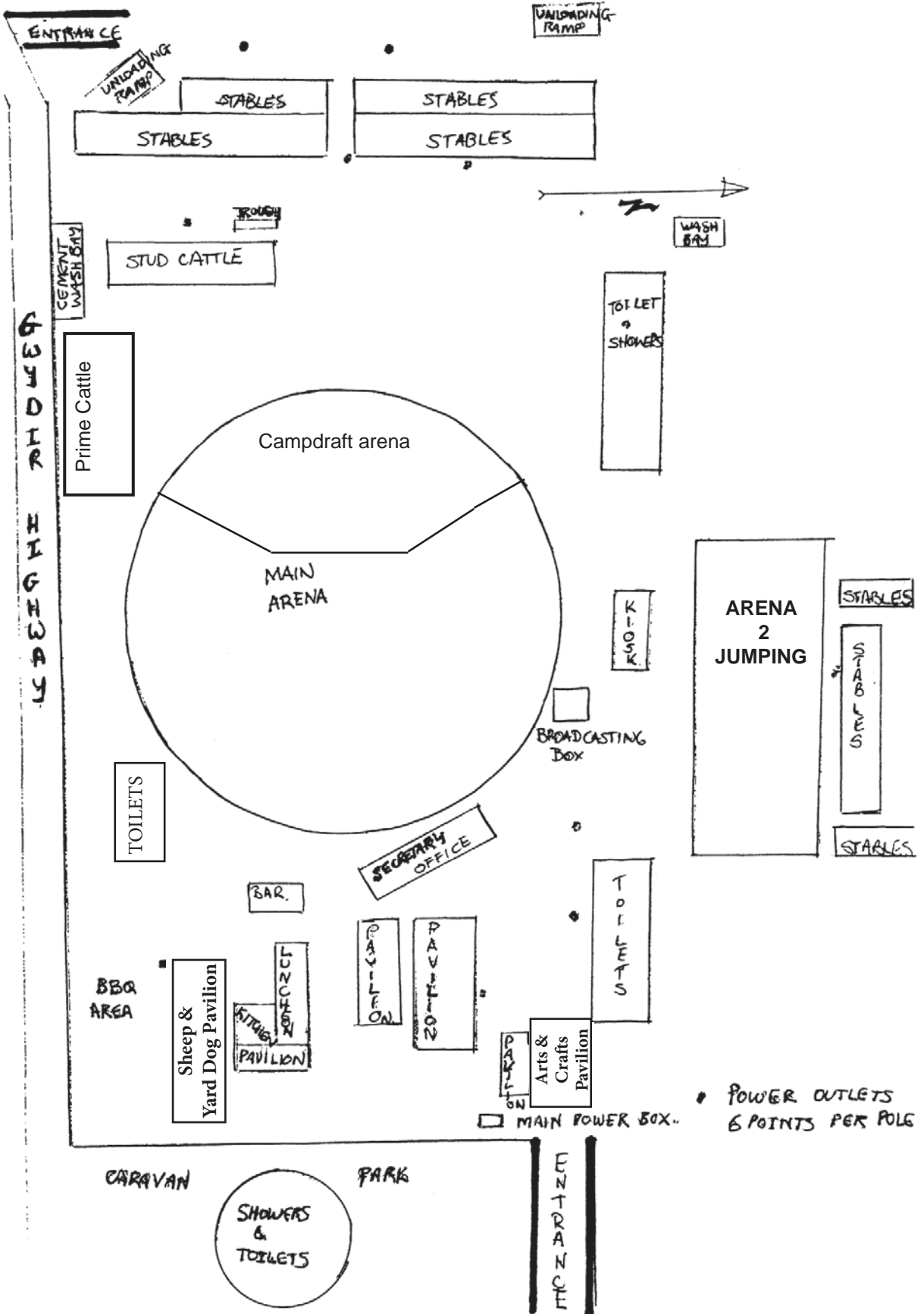


Plan of facilities Warialda Showground

PRIZE MONEY will be paid after judging has been completed. **PRIZES/PRIZE MONEY** will not be mailed and must be collected by 5pm Saturday 10th May 2019 otherwise all prize money automatically reverts to the Warialda P & A Assoc. Inc.

Under no circumstance may you park your car in a stand along ring side which has not been booked and paid for

by you. The committee reserves the right to have said car towed away and impounded, no cost will be incurred by the committee.

CAMPING FEE OF \$15 WILL BE CHARGED TO ALL CAMPERS. TOURISTS WITH CARAVANS AND OTHER VEHICLES \$45.00 ENTRY TO THE RING competitors will be \$3 charged as they enter the ring.

JUMPING ENTRY TICKETS will be available at the Secretary's Office.

HORSE STALLS will not be booked without the payment of \$10 per stall. The stabling steward has the right to request a competitor to remove his/her horses to similar stalls if deemed necessary.

No protests will be dealt with unless accompanied by a \$50 fee to be deposited with the Secretary.

G.S.T. Rules

Warialda P. and A Assoc. AGRICULTURAL SOCIETIES OF NSW

JUDGING COMPETITIONS - RULES and REGULATIONS

1 Competitions covered with these rules are:

BEEF CATTLE JUDGING COMPETITIONS
DAIRY CATTLE JUDGING COMPETITIONS
MERINO SHEEP JUDGING COMPETITIONS
MEAT BREED SHEEP JUDGING COMPETITIONS
FLEECE JUDGING COMPETITIONS
GRAIN JUDGING COMPETITIONS

2 Competitors must be over 15 and under 25 years of age on 1st of May in the year of the State Final at the Royal Easter show.

3 They must be living in NSW or be in regular paid employment there or be in full time education in NSW at the time of first competing in any competition year.

4 No competitor can represent more than 1 Show Society in any one Group Final and no more than 1 Group in a State Final. The winners of a National Final cannot compete at any level in the particular competition that they won.

5 Winners of 2 State Finals in any 1 class shall not be eligible for future competitions in that class.

6 The Hormal Slide or the computer scoring system is to be used at all Group and State Finals.

7 Groups to be entitled to be represented at State level by 2 competitors unless otherwise stated.

8 Merino Judging - Groups to be entitled to be represented at State level by 1 competitor.

9 Group Secretaries must inform the ASC of the name, address & telephone number of any competitor in judging competitions going to the State Finals. The ASC will advise these competitors of the venue and times of the State Final.

10. After the competition is over and awards have been given, the competitors can look at their scores on the master sheet only.

11. Competitors will be eliminated from the competition if deemed by the Chief Steward to be receiving outside assistance.

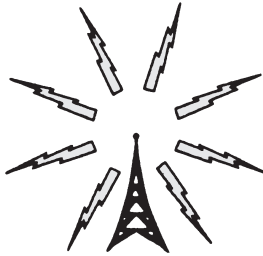

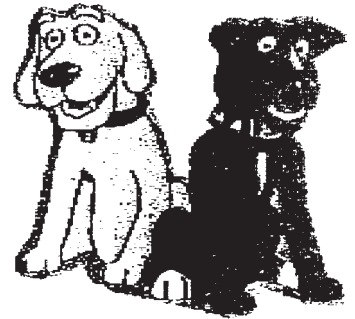

Regulations of the Warialda Pastoral and Agricultural Association Inc.

- 1 All exhibits must be the bona-fide property of the Exhibitor and if requested the Exhibitors must make a Statutory Declaration as to the correctness of his/her entry form in this and other particulars.
- 2 The Warialda P and A Inc. will not be responsible for any accident that may be caused through or by any Exhibit, it shall be blameless and indemnify it against any legal proceedings arising from such accident.
ALL RIDERS competing in jumping events and any other event deemed by the committee must wear skull caps approved by Australian Standards Assoc.
- 3 No Exhibitor or their Agent shall be permitted to be with the Stewards or Judges during the time of Judging of the exhibits, (except in all live stock sections) unless by special request of the Stewards. The Exhibitor, Exhibits, or any person infringing this Regulation shall be at once disqualified.
- 4 Protests must be delivered to the Secretary (in writing) accompanied by amount deemed by the Committee (which shall be forfeited if the Committee considers the appeal frivolous) on, or before the close of the Show.
Upon the disqualification, suspension, or imposition of a penalty in connection with an Exhibitor or Exhibition, the Exhibitor concerned shall be notified by the Secretary that they have the right of Appeal. This will be dealt with by a Disputes Committee consisting of five (5) Committee Members. For the Exhibitor to exercise their Right of Appeal they must within fourteen (14) days deliver to the Secretary an application in writing accompanied by a fee set by the Disputes Committee. Whenever an Appeal is held, the Disputes Committee shall be responsible for the recording of the proceedings and the notation of evidence.
- 5 All Exhibits in the Main Pavilion and Art Pavilion must be grown or made by the Exhibitor. Grains entered in the Farm Produce Section to be in white calico bags, cartons or boxes not less than 3.175kgs.
- 6 In cases where the Exhibitors do not manufacture the Exhibits it will be necessary to give the Manufacturer's name/s.
- 7 No Exhibits shall be allowed to be removed from the Pavilions without the permission of the Chief Stewards before 6pm on the last day of the Show.
No Exhibits shall be rearranged without the permission of the Stewards
- 8 ALL ENTRIES (with the exception of Stud Cattle) to be in the hands of the Secretary by the date stated at the beginning of each Section in the Schedule. These must be on the appropriate Entry Forms found in the Schedule or obtained from the Secretary. Every such Form shall be duly signed by the Exhibitor and the Form shall have the following:- "I declare the Exhibits to be my property or legally in my charge and that it/they are eligible to contest the event/s for which nominated. In consideration of the Assoc. Inc. accepting the enclosed ENTRY FORM and FEE for the events named on this Form, I agree to abide by any decision of the Committee and to release the Warialda P & A Assoc. Inc. and Members from any action, suit, claim or demand I may have against it/them or any of them for or in connection with any loss, damage at or in the course of the Show."
- 9 ENTRY FEES are stated at the beginning of each Section in the Schedule.
Fees for Members and Non-Members stated where they apply.
- 10 Champions are to be selected from the Prize Winners in all Classes, no entry be necessary for Championships.
- 11 In Classes where Exhibits deserve notice and prizes have already been given, the Judge/s shall be empowered to award "Highly Commended" or "Commended" as the case may be.
- 12 ADMISSION FEES are amount deemed by the Committee at their Annual General Meeting prior to each Annual Show and are printed in the front of the Schedule. A rebate will be given to Pensioners on presentation of their card. Child rebate is children aged five (5) and under sixteen (16).
- 13 MEMBERSHIP. The current Membership is set by the Committee at their Annual General Meeting. FULL MEMBERSHIP entitles the Holder to their membership and a Guest Ticket. This Membership also gains you free entry to the ground, car and all children under sixteen (16) years of age, also member rate in entry fees in some Sections where applicable. INDIVIDUAL MEMBERSHIP entitles holder to free entry to the ground and member rate in entry fees in some Sections where applicable.
- 14 Award Ribbons will be distinguished:
 - Blue Ribbon for First
 - Red Ribbon for Second
 - White Ribbon for Third
 - Green Ribbon for Fourth
 - Yellow Ribbon for Fifth
- 15 The Committee is empowered to award a Prize to any Exhibit considered worthy of merit not mentioned in the Schedule.
- 16 A Rebate of a percentage set by the Committee must be returned to the Assoc. Inc. on sales of any Stock or Property sold on the Showground.
- 17 Any Person, who knowingly make false entries for prizes shall forfeit same. The Judge/s will disqualify all Exhibits which do not comply with the terms as stated in the class where the exhibit is entered. The stewards will advise the Judge/s which entries do not comply with the condition.
- 18 The Committee shall not appoint the same Judge/s to judge the same class two (2) years in succession, with the exception of the Fat Stock Section.
