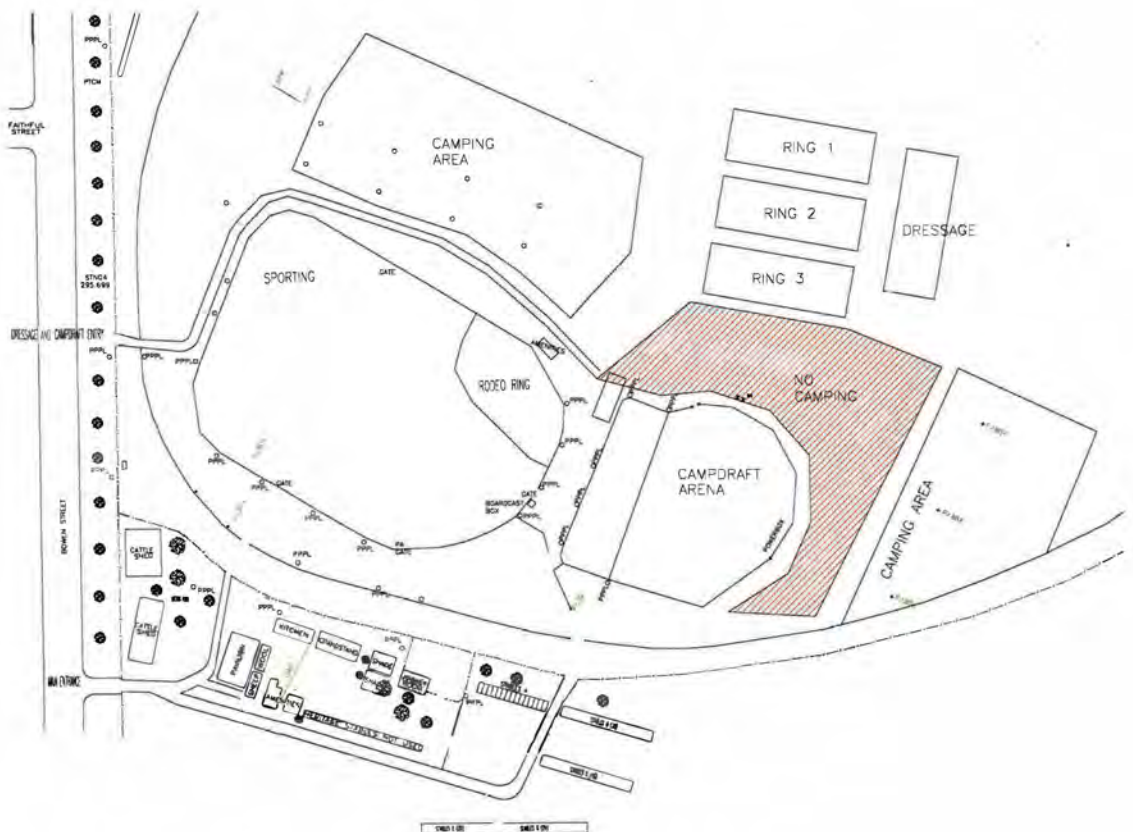

Membership Prices

Exhibitors

Pavilion exhibits will not be received by the Secretary at her office, excepting those forwarded by post or transport, which must be firmly packed, bearing the senders name, Section and Class No. for which the exhibit is intended. Mailed exhibits will be re-packed and returned after the Show if requested. Postage must be prepaid on all mailed exhibits. All Pavilion exhibits must be staged and presented for judging by midday on Friday, 25 May 2018. Sections closing later are clearly stated at the top of each Section.

Notice to all Dog Owners

Any dog found loose or wandering will be impounded by the Ordinance Officer. Owners must remove dog faeces and rubbish immediately.

Conditions of Entry

Competitors/Exhibitors hereby agree to abide by any decision of the Society in regard to entries and agree to compete/exhibit at their own risk and to indemnify and keep indemnified the Society against all claims, suits, actions or demands which may be brought against it in respect of any injuries or other losses sustained by them in the course of competing/exhibiting in any event/s and/or class/es and agree to exonerate the Bingara Show Society from all loss or injury whether from alleged negligence or otherwise.

A WAIVER FORM must be signed before any entry for horse/cattle sections is accepted. All competitors/exhibitors are required to have their own Ambulance Cover. The Society will not be responsible for payment of ambulance transport costs.

Important Notice To all Competitors/Exhibitors

All persons intending to ride, show animals or offer rides involving animals are required to sign an indemnity form prior to competing.

COMPETITORS are asked to call at front of Show Secretary's office prior to competing and sign forms and be given a wristband to show Ring Stewards when competing.

Forms can be downloaded and completed prior to event.

The forms are available for:

1. Competitors - over 18 years old.
2. Competitors - under 18 years old - Note: this to be signed by parent or guardian

Important Notice to all Exhibitors

Any exhibitor intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showground will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tool and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed contractor. This is essential for the safety of yourself, fellow exhibitors and the general public and is a requirement of the Workplace Health and Safety Act, 2011. The Act imposes severe penalties in the event of noncompliance with its provisions. Any exhibitors who do not comply will not be allowed to exhibit at the Bingara Showground. Please check all your electrical equipment and leads before you come.

Electric leads must be overhead or buried - this is a legal requirement and inspectors will police.

Abuse of Judges and Officials

The decision of the judges shall be final and any competitor or exhibitor who abuses either Judges or Officials and is found guilty, after enquiry by the Committee, shall be disqualified from further participation in this Show. A report shall be immediately forwarded to the Northwest Group of Show Societies and Pastoral and Agricultural Associations and will result in automatic suspension of the Competitor or exhibitor from all shows for the remainder of the season.

Please note that NO DOGS are allowed on the Showground.

HORSES RING SECTION COMPETITORS MUST COMPLY WITH CURRENT DPI REQUIREMENTS Ring Steward: Joanne Mitchell on 0435 052 258

REGULATIONS:

All competition at this show is governed by these regulations and by the Agricultural Societies Council of NSW Rules for Discipline in Horse Sections at Shows which can be viewed at www.agshowsnsw.org.au. Should it become necessary for the ASC Disciplinary Committee to open an inquiry into any aspect of competition in this Horse Section, this Society will support any penalty imposed by that Committee as a result of the inquiry and will support penalties resulting from enquiries arising from Horse Sections at other NSW shows.

INDEMNITY AND WAIVER FORMS: The Horse Committee will take all care in managing the Section, but competitors taking part in this Horse Section do so at their own risk. Each adult competitor must, before competing, complete and sign a form indemnifying the Bingara Show Society and waiving any claims against the Society for any injury sustained in competition or for loss or damage to the competitor's property or damage caused by the competitor or his/her animal(s) at the Show. A similar form must also be completed and signed by a parent or guardian for each competitor who is under 18 years of age. ALSO, on each Waiver, each horse with which the competitor is involved in competition at the Show must be listed together with the Property Identification Code (PIC) of the property from which the horse came to the Show.

- All competitors must display an armband (provided once waiver is signed)

ALL RIDERS MUST PROVIDE A PIC NO. ON THEIR SIGNED WAIVER AND DETAILS OF THEIR LAST OUTING

RANDOM DRUG TESTING MAY BE CARRIED OUT AT THIS SHOW.

ANY COMPETITOR FOUND TO HAVE BREACHED THE ASC DRUG TESTING RULES WILL BE PENALISED AS OUTLINED IN ASC RULES FOR DISCIPLINE IN HORSE SECTIONS AT SHOWS

Judges Decision is Final. Protests and complaints received by Secretary on the day of the Show. Protests to be made within ½ hour after Ticket of Award is issued accompanied by a deposit of \$50.00, which will be forfeited if proved frivolous.

An Official Measurer will be on the ground. If any disputes, horses must be measured by appointed measurer. EFA official Height Certificates are accepted.

Competitors entering in events which clash must supply another rider. Rings will not wait for competitors in other classes. Please see ring stewards or ring Horse Convener.


No person other than Judges, Committeemen, Stewards, Riders and Drivers of exhibits allowed inside Ring during Show Days.

Stallions cannot compete in Hacking and Riding Classes, Special Classes excepted.

It is the responsibility of each competitor to ascertain the time scheduled for his/her events and be ready. Competitors who are late may be refused entry to the Ring.

Committee reserves the right to alter, delete/add to the program.

District Horse and rider must live within the Gwydir Shire for 1 month prior to the show. Proof maybe required.

- Entry fee for Rings - \$3 payable to stewards before each class.
- Prize money will only be paid if there are 3 or more in a class, otherwise ribbons only
- Showjumping, Sporting and Dressage entry fees as shown in Catalogue
- Donate ribbons back to the Show Society to go in the draw to win one of three prizes (only ribbons in as new condition will be accepted)
