- INDEMNITY AND WAIVER FORMS: Competitors taking part in this Horse Section do so at their own risk. Each adult competitor MUST, before competing, complete and sign a form indemnifying the Bombala Show Society and waiving any claims against the Society for any injury sustained in competition or for loss or damage to the competitor's property or damage caused by the competitor or his/her animal(s) at the Show. The same form MUST also be completed and signed by a parent or guardian for each competitor who is under 18 years of age. ALSO, on each Waiver, each horse with which the competitor is involved in competition at the Show must be listed together with the Property Identification Code (PIC) of the property from which the horse came from to the Show.
- **Refusal of Entry/Alteration of Schedule:** The committee reserves the right to refuse an entry without assigning any reason for doing so and to alter the schedule to meet emerging circumstances. **NO PIC NO RIDE.**
- Electric Fencing must be erected in accordance with ASC NSW Construction Regulations. No more than 16 m² 2 x strands must be energised. Area's will be designated and supervised by the committee.
- Drug testing may be carried out at this show. Any competition, exhibitor, owner found to have breached the ASC Disputes and Disciplinary Rules will be investigated by the Disputes and Disciplinary Committee and dealt with accordingly.

- Horse Measuring: No official measuring will take place at the show, but, if a question about height arises, proof of height may be required. In the absence of proof, a decision will be at the absolute discretion of the Ring Master or Chief Steward.
- **Judges or Stewards** shall have the power to bar any horse which, in their opinion, should not compete in the class for which it is entered.
- Stable bookings must be made with the Booking Clerk Anita Walder (02) 64587333. Covered horse stall charge fee \$10.00 Camping \$10.00 per site. No stable bookings allowed for horses domiciled within 15 km of Bombala. ALL STABLES ARE TO BE LEFT CLEAN. NO STABLE BOOKINGS WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR THE FOLLOWING YEAR FROM COMPETITORS IF STABLES ARE NOT LEFT CLEAN.
- **Conditions of entry:** All EA Rules apply for the Show jumping. Horse and rider registration numbers must be included on Entry Form. Horse registration and grading card must be presented or no prize money will be awarded.
- **Jumping Rule:** A horse cannot jump any more than 3 times per day or less at the judges discretion.
- Led riders are not permitted in Hack classes.
- **Correct dress** regulations will apply. Helmets must be worn at all times when in jump areas.
- **Full Program of Events:** Due to our full program, events will not be held up for riders taking part in other events at the Show.
- **Event Draw:** Riders must follow draw or may be eliminated from the competition.
- **Event Cancellation:** The committee may at its discretion amend or cancel any event.
- **District Events:** Horse and rider to reside in "the old" Bombala Council area, prior to amalgamation. Stewards/committee may request evidence.
- **Consolation** not placed in similar event at this show.
- **Safety Helmets:** You must comply with the current approval safety standard EA General Regulations.
- **The Judge's decision is final.** Official protest/s must be made in writing within 1 hour of the class being run and must be accompanied by \$50.00 and presented to the Chief Steward.
- **Novice** not placed first in an individual hack or riding class at any Agricultural Show.

The "Nimmity Bell" showjumping pointscore is a competition run over 4 shows – Nimmitabel, Delegate, Dalgety and Bombala. The "Nimmity Bell" trophy is to be awarded to the horse and rider combination with the highest pointscore in open competition over 4 shows. This will be awarded at the completion of EA events at the Bombala Show.

- Only horses registered with the EA of NSW are eligible for the pointscore. Horses can only score in EA events in classes 1.10 m or higher, the event has a total prize pool worth \$100 or more, the event is officiated by an EA accredited Judge and Course Designer. All entrants in these events will be eligible for the "Nimmity Bell Pointscore" regardless of the total amount of entries in one class.
- 2. A horse and rider combination can only score once at each show. This score will be their best placing from that show. If a horse fails to place in an event, it will score zero for that show. The points will be awarded as follows: 1st = 5 points, 2nd = 4 points, 3rd = 3 points, 4th = 2 points, 5th = 1 point, no placing yet eligible = 0 points. In the case of "tied" placings the points will be spilt the same way as prize money.
- 3. Horses must compete at all 4 shows to be eligible for the "Nimmity Bell Pointscore". The only exception will be if an official vet/Drs certificate is presented to the official scorer indicating the horse'/riders' inability to compete at one of the 4 shows. The official point scorer for 2019 is Michael Green 6454 6283).
- 4. Results will be forwarded to Michael for recording from the official Judge/show committee of each show and then allocated points according to the rules above. Any disputes regarding the "Nimmity Bell Pointscore" must be directed to the official point scorer to be dealt with. Official protest/s must be made in writing within 1 hour of the class being completed and must be accompanied by \$50.00 and presented to the Official Point scorer. All events are EA events and will be run in accordance to EA rules.
- 5. EA summer dress standards apply for competitors (no polo shirts shirt with tie or stock to be worn).
- 6. Overall prize money will be awarded to the top 5 place getters at the completion of EA events at Bombala Show.
