- **Sheep to be penned no later than 9.30 am on the day of show.**
- Johnes Disease declaration required. (Provided by Federal Council of Agricultural Societies as part of showground bio-security and the management of animal health).
- Every exhibitor has to fill in a National Sheep Health Statement. A sheep steward must initial this form before unloading sheep at the show.
- One sheep one entry unless otherwise stated. All sheep to be bred by exhibitor. Owners must find holders for their sheep.
- Any exhibitor in doubt as to class in which a sheep is entered is asked to report to Stewards for Judge's decision.
- All Stud Merino Sheep entered in Merino section must be shown in accordance with NSW Sheep Breeders Association Rules and bear Association ear labels. Date of shearing to be stated on entry form for all sheep entered in all classes.
- Sheep will be penned in owners' groups. Once judging is complete, breeders may erect stud sign with name and address of owner. Sign not to exceed 900mm x 600mm.
