HORSE COMPETITION CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The Event will be conducted under EA Rules as Amended.
2. Entry to any class in the competition conditions an authority for the Jerrawa Show Society Inc (The Society) to call an ambulance or medical attention in the event of such services being required and the affected competitor agrees to pay any cost incurred as a consequence.
3. The Society will not be responsible for any accident that may occur. It is a condition of entry that each competitor attending the show shall hold the Secretary blameless and indemnify The Society against any legal proceedings from any such accident.
4. All competitors in all horse events must either present a current EFA card or complete and sign an Animal Indemnity and Waiver Form prior to competing at the Jerrawa Show and will be presented with a wristband. Entry to classes will be denied without the wristband.
5. All competitors in the horse events must provide details of their EA registration if a member and full names of themselves and their horses to the Stewards.
6. All riders must wear a helmet with the chin strap fastened at all times conforming with one of the current approved safety standards: AS/NZ 3838 (2006 onwards provided they are SAI Global marked) or new AS ARB HS 2012 (provided they are SAI Global marked). Wearing is compulsory in all Rings.
7. All entries in Breed classes must be registered and their owner/handler financial with the relevant Society.
8. The Judge, Chief Ring Steward or their representatives may ask for registration papers and proof of financial membership.
9. Competitors must choose between Open Hack and Show Hunters Classes. You cannot compete in both.
10. No horses to warm up in the ring after **8.00am**
11. *THERE WILL BE NO CHANGES TO THIS YEARS PROGRAM ON THE DAY.* Suggestions made in writing will be considered for next year's program.
12. If a ring finishes early, the Chief Horse Steward reserves the right to move outstanding classes to a finished ring.
13. A novice class is for a horse that has not won at any Agricultural Show.
14. A novice rider is a competitor who has not won at any Agricultural Show.
15. All events will be conducted under EA rules.
16. For same sex classes, separate awards for mare, gelding, or stallion will be at the judge's discretion.
17. Stallions and Colts must be in the control of a competent person 18 yrs or over at all times.
18. Stallions and colts 2 years and over to be double tied.
19. Disruptive behaviour or action constituting a safety hazard to others by a competitor or their entry will result in removal from the grounds.
20. From 1 September 2012 anyone who keeps horses in NSW is required to have a Property Identification Code (PIC) for the land on which the horses are kept. It is a requirement that all show societies note the PIC on the Horse Waiver forms.
21. Prize money only awarded in the Show Jumping and Sporting competitions.
22. While rings 1 and 2 will try to accommodate clashes if possible, competitors are responsible for being on time for their class.
23. Ring 3 will not hold for classes and takes priority. Rings 1 and 2 may hold at the Judge's discretion. The Chief Ring Steward reserves the right to move classes to facilitate an early finish.

Agricultural Societies Council of New South Wales Limited and JERRAWA AGRICULTURAL SHOW (together **the Suppliers**) advise that participation (including passive participation) in animal handling at an agricultural show contains elements of risk, both obvious and inherent. The handling of animals is a dangerous recreational activity as animals can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially when frightened or hurt.

1. By signing this waiver I acknowledge that:

- 1.1 participation in animal handling is a recreational service for the purposes of section 139A of the Australian Competition and Consumer Act (Cth) 2010, and also a recreational activity for the purposes of section 5K of the Civil Liability Act (NSW) 2002;
 - 1.2 participation in animal handling is a hazardous activity and may result in injury, loss, damage or death to me;
 - 1.3 participation in animal handling requires certain skills and experience. I declare that I have sufficient skills and experience to be able to safely and properly participate in the events;
 - 1.4 animals can act in a sudden and unpredictable ways, especially if frightened or hurt, or if exposed to loud or unfamiliar noises;
 - 1.5 animal showing events will be held in close proximity to rides and large groups of people, and that there may be loud and unfamiliar noises which can frighten animals;
 - 1.6 if the event is held outdoors, there are risks to me as a result of the weather conditions, including either extreme hot or cold weather, rain or wind;
 - 1.7 insects or other animals may cause animals to become frightened and act in an unpredictable way;
 - 1.8 there is inherent in events involving the handling of animals the risk of suffering injury including injuries caused by animals; and
 - 1.9 I use the facilities supplied for the event entirely at my own risk, as I find them and with the prior acceptance of the risk of possible danger to me.
2. If I suffer injury, loss or damage (Loss) while participating in an animal-handling event, I will not hold the Suppliers, their employees or agents legally responsible for any Loss I suffer. I will not sue the Suppliers, their employees or agents for any claims, costs, damages or liability. I agree to release the Suppliers and their employees from legal responsibility for the services I have been provided and/or activity I have participated in.
3. I acknowledge and agree that my participation in the event and associated activities is dangerous and may have inherent risks as a result of which personal injury (and sometimes death) may occur. I acknowledge that the event and associated activities carry with them a significant risk of physical harm. I accept and assume all such risks of personal injury or death in anyway whatsoever arising from these activities and hereby waive my individual right to sue the Suppliers for all claims I or my representatives may have for such personal injury or death against the Suppliers in any way whatsoever arising from or in connection with these activities.
